Davis-Monthan Air Force Base – Davis-Monthan Air Force Base, AZ (Tucson, AZ)

The base is located within city limits approximately 5 miles, south-southeast of downtown Tucson, Arizona. Area Attractions: Desert Diamond Casino, Tucson Convention Center, Colossal Cave Mountain Park, the Reid Park Zoo, Old Tucson Studios.

Davis-Monthan FAM Camp – Davis-Monthan Air Force Base, AZ (Tucson, AZ)

A top-rated, popular military campground in the Arizona sunbelt. While it is full most of the time in the winter, there is plenty of overflow space and there is a fair rotation policy into the FHU sites. Received the Campers Choice Award for OVERALL BEST Military Campground in 2007, 2008, 2009, 2010 AND 2011 (Western USA)!

198 Hardstand RV Slots. 21 day limit when camp is full, can be renewed for another 21 days if vacancies. FamCamp office open 7 days/week from Oct - Apr and Mon - Fri from May - Sept. Hours are 0800 to 1700. However, the lobby is open 24/7. After 1700 choose available site from board outside of office. Some back-in pads, most are pull thru's. --- Twenty-five sites in the Horseshoe are available for 3- or 6-month contracts. 3-month contracts are available for \$1,890, payable on check-in. 6-month contracts are available for \$3,843, payable upon check-in. No reservations. Guests can stay no more than 21 days at the park before beginning their 6-month stay. After the 6-months (183 days) you must leave the park for for 24 hours. (520) 747-9144

Gila Bend Auxiliary Air Field, Gila Bend, Arizona

Pine View RV Park - Camp Navajo, Bellemont, AZ

Camp Navajo was originally established as Navajo Ordnance Depot in 1942. Within a period of one year, 800 ammunition storage igloos and more than 50 administrative buildings were constructed at a cost of \$19 million. The original mission was the storage of ammunition in support of the Pacific Theatre of operations during the Second World War. 14 Camper and a few tent sites. (928) 699-8866.

Garden Canyon RV Park – Fort Huachuca, Sierra Vista, AZ

Not well known, this is the second RV Park at Ft. Huachuca. Garden Canyon RV Park is part of the Sportmans Club. 12 RV Sites (520) 533-7085

Ft Huachuca Remote Camping – Fort Huachuca, Sierra Vista, AZ

A variety of remote camping spots located around Ft. Huachuca and the range. Availability can be based on range operations and fire conditions. This IS NOT either of the RV Parks at Ft. Huachuca. This is remote camping on Ft Huachuca at various locations. You MUST have a reservation and a permit, as they check the range schedule for activity. (520) 533-6707

Crazy Horse Campgrounds – From I-40 (either direction), take AZ-95 south to Lake Havasu,AZ. Turn right on McCulloch Blvd and go across the London Bridge. Stay right on Beachcomber Blvd for 1/4 mile to the entrance to the campground. Operated under the control of Twentynine Palms Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center, CA

These vacation rentals are situated on a small island in Lake Havasu, the campground provides the ideal combination of privacy and proximity to town. Despite the name, there are NO Military Camping or RV Sites. Rental trailers are 1 bedroom and sleep 4 people. --

Desert Breeze Travel Camp – Yuma Army Proving Ground, Yuma, AZ

A popular winter destination near the Colorado River in a Desert area near California and Mexico. 30 Miles north of Yuma and 27 miles north of Yuma Marine Corp Air Station (MCAS).
