RECOGNIZE: Recognize when you may have encountered a UXO



UXO can be new and shiny or rusted and dirty
 It may or may not look like a bullet or bomb

REPORT: Immediately notify Camp Gruber Range Control or OMD Security



Protect yourself, your family, your friends and your neighbors by immediately reporting **Unexploded Ordnance**


