## Eligibility

- ▣ Have performed at least 20 years of qualifying service (50 points = 1 qualified year) computed on your Anniversary Year Ending (AYE) date.

And

- ▣ You must have not received any form of **Severance Pay**.

## Reduced Retirement For Reserve Component

Under The National Defense Authorization Act for 2008 reduces the retirement age for Reserve Component Soldiers from 60 to a lesser, but not below age 50, for those who have deployed or called to active service by a governor and authorized by the President or the Secretary of Defense under section 502(f) or 115 and 502 (f) of Title 32 USC for purposes of responding to either a national emergency declared by the President or a national emergency supported by Federal funds. For qualifying service on or after 29 Jan 08, each day on that AD tour could count toward a reduction in retirement age. However, even though each day counts, days are credited in aggregates of 90 days only within any Fiscal Year. A day of duty shall be included in only one aggregate of 90 days.

SUBJECT: Full-Time National Guard Duty Qualifying for a Reduced Eligibility Age for  
Receipt of Retired Pay for Non-Regular Service

Pursuant to paragraph 5d of Enclosure 3 of DoD Instruction 1215.07, I have determined that Full-time National Guard duty (FTNGD) performed under section 502(f) of title 32, U.S.C., at the National Special Security Events listed below was pursuant to a call to active service by a Governor, was authorized by the President or the Secretary of Defense to deter or respond to acts of terrorism, and was for the purpose of responding to the national emergency declared in Proclamation 7463 of September 14, 2001. Accordingly, I designate any such FTNGD as qualifying active service for the purpose of reducing the eligibility age for receipt of retired pay for non-regular service in accordance with title 10, United States Code, section 12731(f)(2).

## What Reduced Retirement means for you??????

For every 90 days you mobilized for deployment, since 29 Jan 2008, we can reduce the age you start drawing your retirement pay by 90 days. These days must be consecutive and must fall in the same fiscal year.



## Responsibilities of Soldier

- ▣ Keep Contact information updated with Human Resource Center(HRC) 1-888-276-9472 once discharged from OKARNG.
- ▣ Review NGB 23B (Retirement Point Statement) making sure that there are no errors on it.
- ▣ Getting Updated ID cards



## When to Apply for Retired Pay

- ❑ Soldiers apply for their retired pay 1 year out from their 60<sup>th</sup> birthday.
- ❑ How to apply for your retired pay contact the state, Retirement Service Officer (RSO) 405-228-5318.
- ❑ If Soldier falls under the Reduced Retirement age Soldier will need to contact the state RSO in order to calculate time and determine date of Retirement.
