## Compensation and Pension

## \$1.97 Billion

VA Compensation for service connected disabilities and VA Pensions for low-income Veterans are by far the largest VA benefits programs in Oklahoma.

Over 96,228 Oklahoma Veterans receive compensation for service connected disabilities. Another 4,004 wartime Veterans receive a VA pension.

### Property Tax Exemptions

- SC at 100% and permanently and totally disabled
- Honorably discharge from a branch of the Armed Forces or the OK National Guard

### Sales Tax Exemption

- SC at 100% and permanently and totally disabled
- Sales of tangible personal property or services

### Retirement Benefits Exemption

- SC at 100% and permanently and totally disabled
- Exempt from taxable income not to exceed greater of 75% of such benefits OR \$10,000

#### Motor Vehicles

- ➤ Reduced Fee 50% or greater
- Surviving Spouse qualified if Vet qualified for reduced fee
- You can tag 2 vehicles as long as your name is on the titles.





#### State Park Admission

- Free admission to all state-owned or state-operated parks and museums.
  - Valid OK DL or state photo ID and military discharge papers (DD Form 214) or similar evidence required for free admission.
  - Does not include fees for usage, such as: cabins or camping

### Financial Assistance Programs

- Served 90 days of wartime service,
- One year of Oklahoma residency, and are
- Temporarily injured or income is reduced or changed due to illness, death or disaster.

### Hunting and Fishing Permits

- SC or NSC at 60% or greater
- Disability lifetime combination














#### DISCLOSURE STATEMENT

#### OKLAHOMA VETERANS REGISTRY

#### Verification:

Information included in your registration is subject to verification, validation and periodic updates through sharing between local, state, tribal, or federal governmental entities (collectively referred to hereafter as "Government"). By accepting this disclosure, you are authorizing the State of Oklahoma, Department of Veterans Affairs to access and review your records with the United States Department of Veterans Affairs for the purposes stated above. Failure to provide information required for registration or in connection with verification of eligibility may result in a denial letter and omission from the Veterans Registry until the required information or documentation is provided and qualifying information is substantiated.

#### Information Sharing:

Individual information shall be available to Government entities, and will not be shared with private entities without the express written permission of the veteran or their authorized agent. You may be contacted by a Government representative. Descriptive statistical information on the Oklahoma veteran population and any subset thereof may be shared with governmental or private entities. ODVA may wish to send you regular updates or communications such as newsletters from the ODVA or other partnering agencies or activities. If you do not wish to receive such communications, please indicate below:







