

MISHAP CLASSIFICATION & PROCEDURE CHART

AN ARMY ACCIDENT (OR MISHAP) IS DEFINED AS AN UNPLANNED EVENT OR SERIES OF EVENTS, WHICH RESULTS IN ONE OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING:

- Occupational illness to Army Military or DA Civilian personnel.
- · Injury to on-duty DA Civilian personnel.
- Injury to Army Military on duty or off duty.

• Damage to Army property.

 Damage to public or private property and/or injury or illness to non-Army personnel caused by Army operations (the Army had a causal or contributing role in the accident).

CLASS A MISHAP PROCEDURE

1. Notify the appropriate first responders if necessary.

2. Notify the OKARNG State Safety Office (SSO) at 405-228-5003 or

3. Notify your supervisor and run your unit-specific pre-accident plan.

4. Notify the USACRC immediately by phone at DSN 558-2660/3410

5. Notify OSHA within eight hours of a civilian workforce fatality at

800-321-6742 or online at https://www.osha.gov/report.html.

If unable to notify the SSO, please proceed with the following:

DID THE MISHAP RESULT IN ONE OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING?

- Property damage totals \$2 million or more.
- An Army aircraft is destroyed, missing, or abandoned
- An injury or occupational illness results in a fatality or permanent total disability.



DID THE MISHAP RESULT IN ONE OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING?

- Property damage totals \$500,000 or more but less than \$2 million.
- An injury or occupational illness results in permanent partial disability.
- Three or more personnel are hospitalized as inpatients as the result of a single occurrence.



CLASS B MISHAP PROCEDURE

- 1. Notify the appropriate first responders if necessary.
- 2. Notify the OKARNG SSO at 405-228-5003 or 405-421-1701.
- 3. Notify your supervisor and run your unit-specific pre-accident plan.

If unable to notify the SSO, please proceed with the following:

- 4. Notify the USACRC immediately by phone at DSN 558-2660/3410 or commercial 334-255-2660/3410.
- 5. Notify OSHA within **24 hours** of a civilian workforce fatality at 800-321-6742 or online at https://www.osha.gov/report.html.

DID THE MISHAP RESULT IN ONE OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING?

- Property damage totals \$50,000 or more but less than \$500,000.
- A nonfatal injury or occupational illness that causes one or more days away from work or training beyond the day or shift on which it occurred.



DID THE MISHAP RESULT IN ONE OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING?

- Property damage totaling \$20,000 or more but less than \$50,000.
- A nonfatal injury or illness results in restricted work, transfer to another job, treatment beyond first aid, needle stick injuries, and cuts from sharps contaminated from another person's blood or other potentially infectious material, medical removal under medical surveillance requirements, or occupational hearing loss.
- A work-related tuberculosis case.

1. Notify the appropriate first responders if no

- 1. Notify the appropriate first responders if necessary.
- 2. Notify the OKARNG SSO at 405-228-5003 or 405-421-1701.
- 3. Notify your supervisor and run your unit-specific pre-accident plan.

If unable to notify the SSO, please proceed with the following:

- 4. Aviation Class C: Immediately notify the USACRC at DSN 558-2660/3410 or commercial 334-255-2660/3410.
- 5. Ground Class C: USACRC notification is not required.

 Property damage totaling \$5,000 or more but less than \$20,000.

- 1. Notify the appropriate first responders if necessary.
- 2. Notify the OKARNG SSO at 405-228-5003 or 405-421-1701.

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DID THE MISHAP RESULT IN THE FOLLOWING?

 Aircraft turbine engine damage because of unavoidable foreign object damage (FOD) (does not include auxiliary power unit).



DID THE MISHAP RESULT IN ONE OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING?

- A non-duty fatality, permanent partial disability, or injury/illness that affects mission readiness (loss or restricted duty).
- Property damage that totals less than \$5,000.
- On-duty illness or injury that can be treated with basic first aid.

CLASS F MISHAP PROCEDURE

- $1. \\ Notify the appropriate first responders if necessary.$
- 2. Notify the OKARNG SSO at 405-228-5003 or 405-421-1701.
- 3. Notify your supervisor and run your unit-specific pre-accident plan.
