## OKLAHOMA ARMY NATIONAL GUARD (OKARNG) MILITARY RECORD REQUEST SIGNATURE VALIDATION

- 1. REFERENCES.
  - a. Standard Form 180, Request Pertaining to Military Records
- b. Army Regulation 25-22, The Army Privacy and Civil Liberties Program, Paragraph 6-2, 30 September 2022
- 2. PURPOSE. The purpose of this memorandum is to provide instruction for validation of signatures on military record requests.
- 3. APPLICABILITY. This policy applies to all requests for military records.
- 4. POLICY. Effective 01 December 2022, a Driver's License, State ID, Passport, Military ID, or Authorized Signature Notarized, will be required as "Proof of Identification" for all military record requests by the following:
  - a. Service Member.
  - b. Member's Legal Guardian. Provide copy of "Letters of Guardianship".
  - c. Next-of-Kin if the Service Member is deceased.
- (1) The surviving next-of-kin may be the un-remarried surviving spouse, father, mother, son, daughter, sister, or brother.
- (2) The requester must provide proof of death, such as a copy of a death certificate, newspaper article (obituary) or death notice, coroner's report of death, funeral director's signed statement of death, or verdict of coroner's jury.
